That way we'll all succeed together.

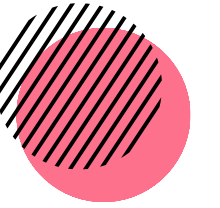

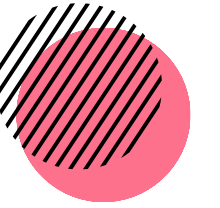

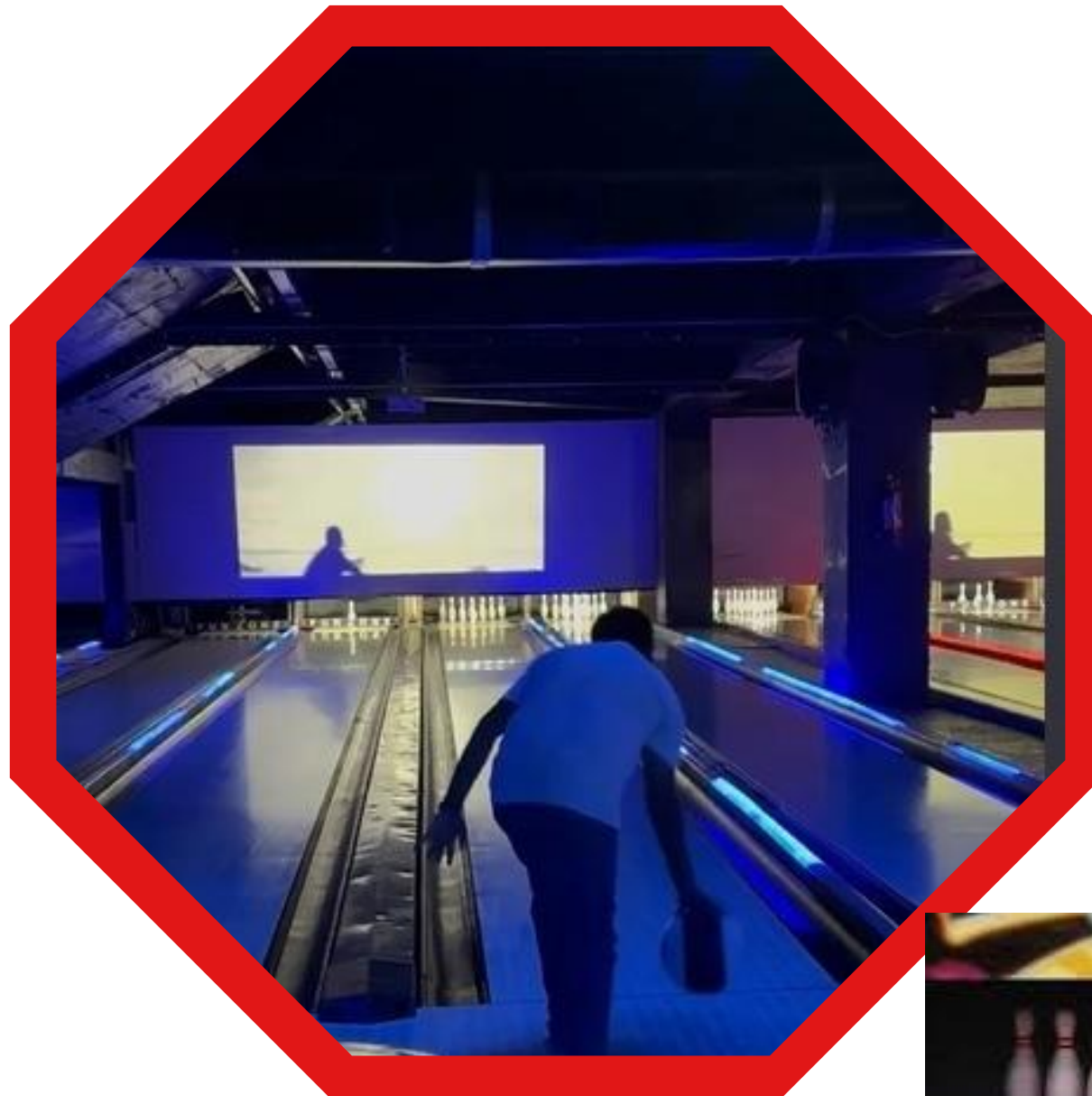
